#### **FASTING "REGULATIONS"**

#### STRICT ABSTINENCE

The law of strict abstinence forbids the use of meat, eggs and dairy products or any of their byproducts. *All faithful adults, who receive Eucharist, are obliged to observe strict abstinence* on the first day of the Great Fast (Monday 2/12), on Great and Holy Friday as well as all day Holy Saturday, until midnight.

#### SIMPLE ABSTINENCE

The law of simple abstinence forbids the use of meat or meat byproducts, permitting the use of eggs and dairy products. Abstinence is to be observed on all Wednesdays and Fridays during the Great Fast.

# Explanation of Lenten practices in the Byzantine Church

### The 40 Days

Byzantine Lent begins on the Sunday evening (which begins Monday) before what in the Latin Church would be Ash Wednesday. The forty days of Lent are counted continuously including Saturday and Sunday from Monday up until Great Week (Holy Week). Great Week is a separate penitential week in itself.

#### **Great Canon of St. Andrew of Crete**

This is a Matins service but usually celebrated in the evenings during Lent. Through poetic and poignant verses the Great Canon takes us through the entire Bible denoting instances of sin, repentance and redemption. When this service is celebrated in its entirety on the Thursday of the fifth week of Lent, the story of St. Mary of Egypt is read.

#### **Pre-Sanctified Liturgy**

Since the Divine Liturgy has a Resurrectional element, the Byzantine tradition abstains from celebrating the Divine Liturgy during the weekdays of Lent. But since the Eucharist is essential to our spirituality, the Byzantine tradition celebrates the Liturgy of the Pre-sanctified Gifts where we receive the Eucharist that has already been consecrated during the prior Saturday or Sunday Divine Liturgies.

#### **Prostration**

The posture of repentance with our entire body bowing to the ground.
